


HUNTING UNITS AND REGULATIONS


- <u>Buck Deer Cache General Unit</u>. Tags are acquired through the Utah draw system with relatively good drawing odds. Depending on weapon type you could expect to obtain this Utah deer permit most years.
- <u>Bull Elk Cache Wellsville General Unit</u>. Tags can be obtained over the counter, but there are only 17,500 rifle, muzzleloader, and multi-season permits that are sold on a first come first serve basis, and often sell out quickly. Archery permits are unlimited in number and available over the counter.
- <u>Bull Moose Cache Moose Unit</u>. Moose tags are issued through a once in a lifetime draw system. This unit boasts some of the highest populations and biggest bull moose in the state.
- <u>Turkeys Northern Region General</u>. There are two separate seasons for turkeys: spring and fall. Permits are available over the counter, with one permit allowed in the spring, and up to three in the fall.
- <u>Upland Birds and Small Game General Hunting License</u>. Pheasants, Forest Grouse, and Small Game can all be found and hunted on the ranch, and require only a general hunting license. The exception to this is the Sharp Tail Grouse which requires a special permit drawn through the state application system in July. This area of Utah contains some of the largest populations of sharp tail grouse in the state. They are easily found and hunted on Birch Creek Ranch.















